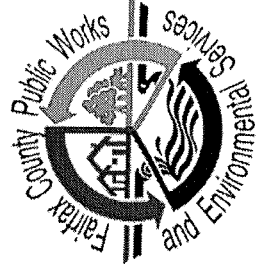

III. Consultant Qualifications
