The next step we're hoping for is approval of \$3 million in funding to prepare a final levee design.

What happens that night?

- Between 5:30 p.m. and 10 p.m. neighbors, friends and families lock their doors, turn on outside lights and spend the evening outside together.
- Police officers visit with as many neighborhood gatherings as possible.

### Adopt-A-Highway – Huntington Avenue
