Community Parking Regulations in the Mt. Vernon District

Huntington residents are reminded that the following vehicles may not be parked on public streets in residential areas of the Mt. Vernon district, which includes Huntington: boats and boat trailers, motor homes, camping trailers, trailers even if attached to a vehicle, vehicles with three or more axles, and those transporting 16 or more passengers (except school buses). In general, commercial vehicles that exceed 12,000 lbs gross weight, 8' in height, or 21' in length, are also prohibited. Exceptions include those being used for loading, unloading, or preparing for a trip, and some service company vehicles, which may park temporarily on-street for up to 48 hours. Taxicabs and limousines are limited to one per single-family dwelling. Questions and violations may be directed to the Mt. Vernon Police Dept at 703.691.2131, or visit

Note: These regulations are in addition to those requiring vehicles to display valid state license tags and inspection stickers and to be operable, whether on-street or on private property. Also, the VA Dept of Transportation prohibits driving over curbs to park in driveways or lawns.
